New ACCESS Exit Band Process

- **Grade 3-8**
 - WIDA ACCESS Overall 4.3-4.7 & Proficient or Above on OSTP ELA
- **Grade 9-12**
 - WIDA ACCESS Overall 4.3-4.7 & At or above the 35th percentile on approved assessments for EL Band Exit
- **Students meeting the above criteria will automatically exit the EL program.**



New Alt ACCESS Exit Band Process

- **Grade 3-8 & 11**
 - WIDA Alt ACCESS Overall 3.0 & Basic or Above on OAAP ELA
- **Students meeting criteria in grades 3-8 & 11 will automatically exit the EL program.**
- **Grade 9, 10, & 12**
 - WIDA Alt ACCESS Overall 3.0 & Complete the Alternate ACCESS ELP Band Exit Recommendation Form



- **Semester Date Entry**
 - Districts have different semester end dates
 - Done in the Admin portal
- **Only one record per student, per semester**
 - 1st record requires semester date entry
- **Can be edited by any teacher who is assigned to the student in CIS**
- **System allows for back-dating**





- Low scores (1) account for only 18.88%, while high scores (4 and 5) are rare (12.44% and 1.32%)




